Cooling Assistance

Helps eligible households with the cost of cooling their homes (must meet certain income guidelines, need and there must be an elderly person, person with a disability or child under 6 living in the home). Applications accepted from June 15-August 15.

Crisis Assistance

Offers assistance for eligible households in emergency energy situations that cannot be met by Fuel Assistance or other resources. Applications accepted from November 1-March 15. All assistance based on availability of funds.

Emergency Burial/Medical Assistance

Offers emergency assistance with burials and emergency medical needs on a limited basis.

Fuel Assistance

Helps eligible households with the cost of heating their homes (must meet certain income guidelines, resource maximums, and living arrangements). Applications accepted from the 2nd Tuesday in October to the second Friday in November.

Refugee Assistance

Provides short-term maintenance payments for indigent refugees.

TANF (Temporary Assistance to Needy Families)

Provides aid to families with dependent children; Offers payments to needy persons caring for related children under the age of 18 or 21, if patient is a student (through Grade 12) who needs support due to death, disability, or absence of parent(s), and sometimes employment; Offers limited aid to unrelated children.
